

**Summer Reading Assignment
For
Incoming Seventh Graders**

In an effort to get you ready for seventh grade work, Mrs. Howe and Mrs. Latham want you to read this summer. Below, please find your summer reading assignment:

Personal Choice:

Choose any book that you like that is seventh-grade appropriate (and over 100 pages). While reading this book, we want you to stop **four times** (this could be after reading a couple of chapters, after reading 30 pages, after reading for 30 minutes—you decide) to write a journal entry. This journal entry is simple: it's two paragraphs long. The first paragraph should be a summary of what you have read. The second paragraph should be a reflection of what you have read. A reflection is just what you think about what you have read: how does it make you feel...what does it make you think about...can you relate what you have read to anything else (like other books, movies, television shows, something in your own life). Remember to include with the journal entry the pages or chapters that you are writing about. Also, include the book's title and author. Please put your entries into a single-subject spiral bound notebook. You will use this notebook for reading next year!

We will start seventh grade off with reading projects. This book / journal will be used as a springboard into these projects. More about that in September!!!
